I hope you and all of the Jaguars Booster Club members know how much Wayne and I appreciate your support of the Jaguars and the Jaguars Foundation. The Boosters have given countless hours of volunteer service for Foundation projects such as the Straight Talk™ television show, FIRST BOOK children's books distribution, game day pins distribution during training camp, and helping to staff the Season of Firsts and Jaguars memorabilia table in the spring. WOW! you all have been busy and are truly the goodwill ambassadors of the team and the Foundation. We thank you!

In 1998 the Boosters surprised me with a check presentation to the Foundation in the amount of \$10,100.93. That year and every year since, I have told the group that we would put their contribution to work for the benefit of children. We have done that, however, it is now time to do more.

It is my pleasure to share that the Jaguars Foundation will make a grant in the amount of \$64,000, representing the total contribution made by the Boosters to the Foundation. Our grant will be made to the Boys and Girls Clubs of Northeast Florida for the new National Football League Youth Education Town (NFL-YET). In recognition of this contribution, the multi-purpose room at the NFL-YET will be named in honor of The Jacksonville Jaguars Booster Club. We are honored to recognize the Boosters for their support.

As part of the legacy of hosting Super Bowl XXXIX in Jacksonville, the newly constructed youth center operated by the Boys and Girls Clubs will provide after-school and summer educational support and tutoring, a computer lab, recreational, sports, arts and social programming for 150 children daily living in the Brentwood area with special programming for other youth in coordination with other non-profit partners. A Family Services wing coordinated by United Way will provide additional family services.

Beginning with a "soft" opening in November with a smaller number of children, the grand opening will be in February 2008. You will receive more information about the grand opening. We hope that the NFL-YET becomes another outreach option for which some of the Boosters may volunteer.
